Oneida County ATV Club Monthly Meeting, May 11, 2016

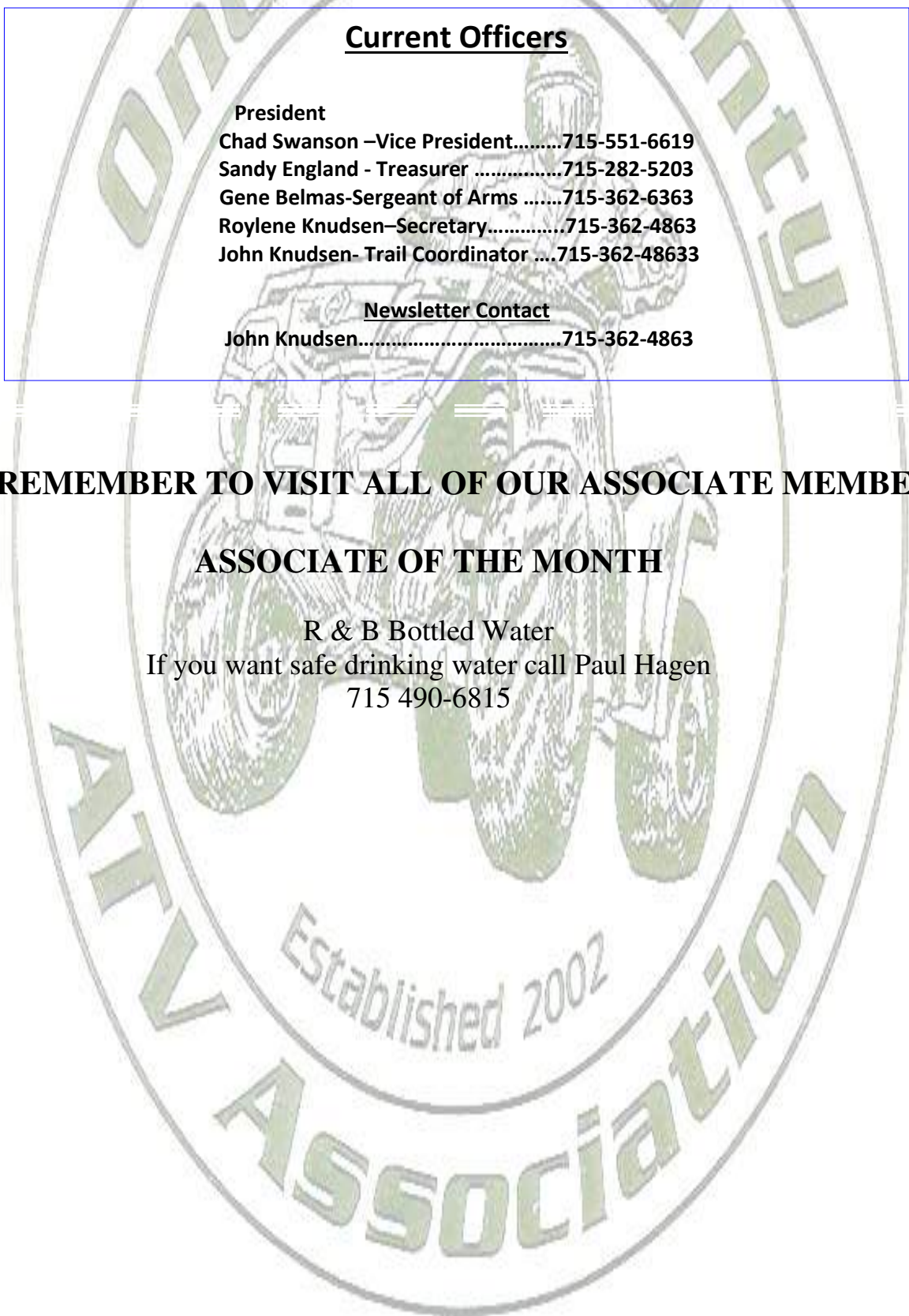

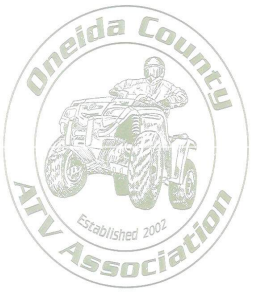
