Oneida County ATV Club Monthly Meeting, July 12, 2016

Meeting was called to order at 6:10 pm by Vice President Chad Swanson. There were 18 in attendance. The Treasurer and Secretaries reports were accepted as read.

Trail Report – The senior ride went very well with 17 machines participating and 16 seniors riding. The ride was finished up with a great meal at the shelter. Even the weather cooperated. Plans are to have more rides in the future.

More signage is ordered for the trail that is needed and Aug. 16 is set aside to put up that signage and for some trail maintenance.

A truck is needed to haul gravel and the club has some of the rock gravel on hand that could be put in place to help with wash outs.

Char has updated all but one of the map boxes and should not need to order more until Nov. Thanks Char for doing that task.

For trail safety a motion was made that when heavy equipment is being used on the trail there will be 2 flag people to put up signage and make riders aware of the work on the trail. This was passed.

Gene gave a report on the Pine Lake ATV-UTV club. They will be putting up 40 new route signs and plans are being formalized to hold a rally in the parking lot of the fire department. If this comes about more information will be forthcoming.

It was mentioned that for the brat sales a sign could be made telling the patrons what things the club does for the community. People may like to know what they are supporting. Bring ideas to put on the sign to the next meeting.

This Month's SAFETY TIPS

You must slow your ATV-UTV to 10 mph or less when you are riding an ATV-UTV within 150 feet of a home; 100 feet of an ice fishing shanty; 100 feet of a person who is not on an ATV, UTV, snowmobile or motorcycle, or in a motor vehicle. You must slow for hikers, anglers, bicyclists, joggers, horses, etc.

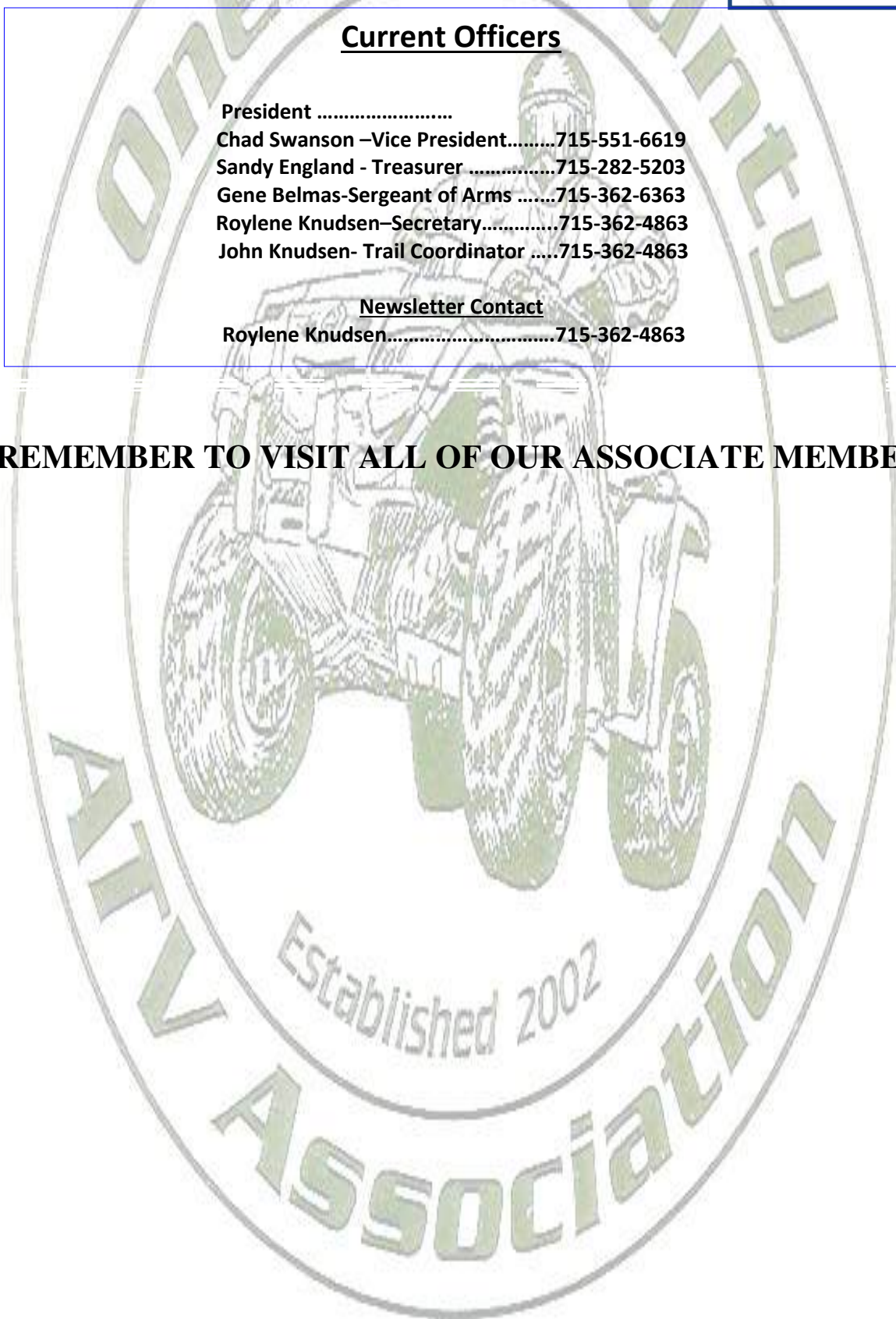

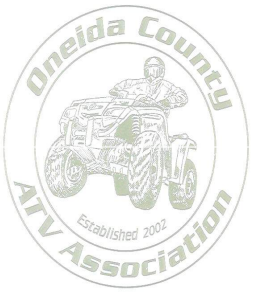
