Oneida County ATV Club Monthly Meeting, November 8, 2016

Meeting called to order by Chad Swanson, Vice President. Minutes from October meeting were read and accepted. Treasurers report was read and accepted.

Trail Report: Breaker rock should be done this year and ready to use on the trail in the Spring. Dean Bettinger finished the bulldozing on East Loop between Shingle Mill and Cinder Rd. Logging is still being done and signage will need to be checked in the Spring.

A question was ask "Do the loggers have to put the trail back to something similar as to how they were" and the answer is that the Forestry department will decide who will be responsible for putting it back.

John mentioned that on Friday November 11th there will be 4 high ranking DNR officials riding the trails. They want to check on Oneida County trails and where the new trails that will be made for the Pel-cho Mudd Nuttz ATV club.

New business: John had notice that the club might be interested in entering the downtown Christmas Parade Dec 3. It was decided to participate and if you have ideas and can help call John or plan to help set up on Saturday morning Dec. 3rd.

We can put a free add in the WATVA magazine and looking for someone to set that up and turn it in to the magazine by Feb. 15, 2017.

Sandy England has the forms to fill out to receive the Chamber money. This money will be used for advertising if received. It was decided to have two more signs made that tell what things the club does for the community. John also mentioned the maps on the trail that shows where a person is at on the trail are fading and should be replaced.

The website is having some glitches but can be found. When the website if doing well it has been mentioned to put the newsletter on the website. For some this would work for others it will not, so having feedback from members would be helpful. It was mentioned to make up a notice giving the website information to be sent out with new member material. Then get feedback from new members as to how they would like to receive the newsletter.
