Hello Hodag 4-Wheelers ATV-UTV Club Members –

Meeting called to order at 6:00 pm by President Paul Hagen.

August's minutes were read by John K. and accepted by those present.

Treasurer's report was read by Diane D. and accepted by those present.

President's Report:

Forestry meeting on opening roads in Enterprise Forestry system needs to go to Council for approval. Should be taken care of soon. Oneida County Council of ATV/UTV want to make a motion to authorize a \$100.00 dollar reward for information on people vandalizing signs and being caught. Also, Lake Tomahawk area needs support from surrounding clubs on getting that area open to riders.

Vice President's Report:

Newbold area he has seen and stopped many young people riding the roads, 17 and younger doing wheelies, riding without helmets, and for those under the age of 16 riding without adult supervision, so please if you live in that area be aware that most of those actions are illegal.

Trail Report:

Overall trail is in good condition. There are a few minor spots that need a light touchup and some signage is faded and needs to be replaced in the Spring. With new DNR regulations, lights must be on and if high beams are in use, they must be dimmed when coming upon traffic from front or back and within 500 feet. That also includes those large LED lightbars. No person (except emergency services) may operate an ATV/UTV that emits any color of light other than white or amber, that is visible from directly in front of that ATV/UTV. A lamp that emits any color of light other than red, yellow, amber, or white that is visible from directly behind the ATV/UTV. A flashing, oscillating or rotating light that emits any color other than yellow or amber is not authorized.

There will be a workday September 23rd & 24th starting at 9:30 am. Starting point on 1st day will be at the East gate on Shingle Mill Rd. The workday will involve grading the entire trail with some repair if we can find a volunteer with a 4-wheel drive truck to pull a dump trailer.

Old Business: The club has joined the Rhinelander Chamber of Commerce. Club is still working on a map of the immediate area for information on routes and trails.

There will be a fundraiser ride on October 10th associated with the Woodpecker Bar & Grill. 5th Annual fundraiser for the Hodag 4-Wheelers ATV/UTV club. Ride will start at 9 am from Bowman Rd. parking lot. \$20.00 for driver and \$10.00 for each passenger. Club will also have a 50/50 raffle, with dinner at 5:30pm back at the Woodpecker. Meeting adjourned at 7:10 pm.
