




OVERNIGHT RIDE POSSIBILITY

WHEN: Friday, August 18 (check-in) to Sunday, August 20 (check-out)

WHERE: Trail Side Motel, Danbury, Wisconsin (Burnett County) - \$99 per night plus tax
(8) Rooms are available - each have two queen beds.

This destination and timing is a suggestion only for you to consider as a club overnight adventure. I do not have any experience in the area. All the information I have included is obtained by reading through tourism sites and material found on the internet. I arrived at Danbury because of lodging opportunities for (8) rooms for an affordable rate and for the weekend of August 18. Although I have (8) rooms reserved, they can be cancelled without penalty.

The St. Croix Casino is also in Danbury and may have rooms available. They would not allow me to reserve a block of rooms. So all members would need to make their own reservations. Weekend rates there are \$132. There are other smaller lodging opportunities in the area if we need to find more rooms.

The communication text included is with Garry Brooks, of the Turf and Tundra ATV Club in Danbury. Garry is a Trail Ambassador and is a resource for us.

SHORTER RIDE POSSIBILITIES:

- 17.5 mile loop. Go south of hotel to Trail 8, traveling on Swiss Fire Lane, Carters Bridge Road, along Briggs Lake Road, cross Lake 26 Road and Hwy 77 to Trail 45 (intersection 63). Trail 45 back to hotel.
- Increase above loop by 7 miles, staying on Trail 8 to Trail 41. Then Trail 45 back to hotel.
- Increase again by 7 miles, staying on Trail 8 all the way to club route (Deer Lake Road and N Webb Lake Road to Trail 41 (intersection 67). Then Trail 45 back to hotel.
- 50 mile loop. Connect to Trail 45 on southwest side of Danbury, to Welch Road, Dvorak, Cty FF, Yellow Lake Road, Park Street, CCC Road, Minnow Lake Road and Deerpath Road to Trail 41. Take Trail 41 to Trail 8 (intersection 61). Take Trail 8 back to hotel. Ride is 50% routes.

LONGER RIDE POSSIBILITIES:

- A trail going east from Danbury approx. 18 miles leads you into Washburn County just past Webb Lake, to Trail 7. Traveling 13 miles SE leads to a 15 mile loop. Going back same way ends up being approx. a 77-mile ride.
- A trip to Trego is approximately 51 miles. Almost the same ride as above, but not looping back. After
 the initial 18 miles from Danbury to Webb Lake, 21 more miles of trail are followed by a 12 mile route.
 Plan on 102 miles round trip going back same way.
- · From Trego, it is approx. 5 miles to Spooner on the Wild Rivers Trail.
- Starting just north of Trego, there is a 45 mile loop, (ending back at Trego) that is the ATV Scenic Tour.
 It is a self-guided trip, using a map that identifies 35 points of interest.
- Instead of completing the full ATV Scenic Tour Loop, going a CCW direction for 33 miles will bring you to Minong. Getting back to Danbury is a 21 mile route followed by 18 of trail. Total length of this trip is approx. 123 miles.
- 104-mile Wild River Trail—stretches thru Douglas, Washburn and Barron County and links the communities of Superior, Solon Springs, Gordon, Minong, Trego, Spooner, Haugen and Rice Lake. An old rail trail, the surface is highway grade compacted gravel and railroad ballast.

OTHER ATTRACTIONS:

In addition to riding the trails, here are some other attractions you may want to visit while you are in the area:

- Wisconsin Great Northern Railroad in Trego. They have a dinner train ride and a wine and cheese train ride.
- Crex Meadows in Grantsburg.
- Duluth/Lake Superior Harbor, approximately 80 miles away, is home to the massive shipping ships (1,000 footers).
- Big Manitou Falls at Pattison State Park are the 4th highest falls east of the Rockies. A State Parks sticker is required. This is in Douglas County.
- Amnicon Falls State Park in Douglas County.
- Tommy's Too High Wines in Danbury.
