HELP NEEDED

Our club needs an immediate successor to Amy Ciaccio as secretary. Amy and her husband Tom have relocated to Tennessee. The secretary is an elected two-term position (odd years) and also serves on the Executive Committee. The secretary documents and preserves all meeting minutes and performs other general secretary duties as requested by the Executive Committee. The secretary will also receive general information requests from the public via email that requires parsing and distribution to a club member who may be best to address the request. Good note-taking skills and computer word processing application skills are helpful.

CLUB OFFICER OPENING - TRAIL COORDINATOR

The Trail Coordinator and a team of club volunteers, on behalf of the Hodag 4-Wheelers ATV-UTV Club, work diligently to ensure a 12.6-mile section of trails are safe for all riders who travel them. The trail work may include cutting and removing fallen trees from the trail, clearing brush that encroaches the trails, minor trail surface repair, repair or erection of traffic signage, etc.

Our club works under contract (renewed annually) with the Oneida County Forestry, Land & Recreational Department, who relies on our club to maintain a significant portion of the Enterprise Trail System in Oneida County. This department, in cooperation with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, rewards our club financially for trail work efforts and compensates us for costs incurred up to a pre-approved limit. The club receives a lump sum amount check in July of each year.

The Trail Coordinator or a member of the trail work team completes a log sheet for each trail work event, which accounts for the total hours each participant works and the equipment they used during the event, including truck, trailer and ATV or UTV if used, chainsaw, string trimmers and other tools. Data from the log sheets is transferred to an electronic report form and submitted to the Oneida County Forestry monthly.

The Trail Coordinator and/or a member of the trail work team will routinely ride the trails checking for issues, particularly following a storm event where there is high potential for fallen trees to block the trail. The Trail Coordinator, the club president, and an Oneida County Forester will do an inspection ride together in the spring, before the trails are officially opened, to ensure the trails are safe and in compliance to the Oneida County Forestry Department guidelines.

The Trail Coordinator is a member of the Executive Committee, serving a 2-year term following election at the club Annual Meeting in even years. The Trail Coordinator is the primary liaison between the Hodag 4-Wheelers ATV-UTV Club and the Oneida County Forestry Department for all general communications and exchange of information. The Trail Coordinator reports on recent trail work activity and trail condition at the monthly club meetings.

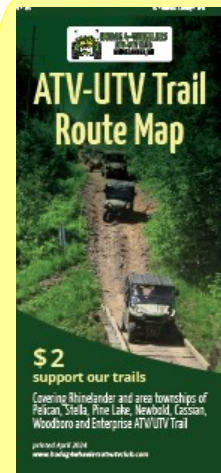
