We had 5 kinds of chili, hot dogs, buns, pickles, and 2 desserts for dinner. It was a nice turnout, and many people who were not members came by!




Ten machines went on the night ride. Seventeen people rode from about 5:30 pm to about 8 pm.




Share Night Fundraiser—Dairy Zueen September 10, 2025
