Sponsor Appreciation Gatherings – An appreciable gathering of members met regularly at a few of our club sponsors the last three months to show them our appreciation for sponsoring our club. 4th of July Parade - This year is the 250th anniversary of our country. We could continue to participate in the parade with each of us driving our decorated ATV or UTV. Or, we could do something a bit more spectacular in honor of this great occasion. Consider that we have a handsome orange tractor that could pull a flat deck trailer. We have a mascot. I am not sure, however, if we have any fife or snare drum players. But we do have a little time to get organized. Please give us your input. Also, please contact an officer and volunteer to be the chairperson for this event.

2026 Cash Raffle - We have (500) 2026 “hot pink” cash raffle tickets available for sale. Ticket cost and payouts are the same as last year; and winners will be drawn during our Poker Run in October. Trail Maps - Our map committee is in the process of having awesome new trail maps printed for the upcoming two seasons. Once the new maps arrive, over 30 map boxes will be filled and distributed to businesses throughout the area. If you would like to help distribute & manage a map box, contact Roger or Nancy Watry.

Thank you, Linda Gary, and the map committee for acquiring our 50 map sponsors and for the tedious effort in development of the map, including interface with the map developing and printing company.

Meat Raffle – Old man Winter tried to interfere with warnings about a historical snowstorm but failed. We held our meat raffle again this year in conjunction with the St. Patty’s Day Parade in downtown Rhinelander at Bucketheads Bar & Grill. Many of the happy holiday revelers went home with some meat and other nice prizes they won by participating in our fundraiser. We thank Bucketheads Bar & Grill again for hosting our event. Overnight Ride - Our overnight ride this year explores the Keweenaw Peninsula in the Michigan UP. We will bed down in Calumet (approx. 20 minutes north of Houghton/Hancock) and plan to travel up to the tip of the peninsula north of Copper Harbor.

As of 2/3/26, a total of (19) rooms are reserved for members or guests of our club at the Trailside Lodge, 57900 US Highway 41, Calumet, MI 49913. Everyone must call the Lodge (906-337-9905) and make their own reservations. Reference that you are a member of the Hodag 4-Wheelers ATV-UTV Club to claim one of the rooms. They have single kings, single queens, and double queen size rooms in our block. Most of us will be checking in on Friday, September 11th and checking out on the morning of September 13th.



Rooms are \$189 total (including tax) per night. A \$10 discount will be applied if you were in the military. There will be an added 4% convenience fee for all credit card payments. NOTE: If you pay with a debit card, the 4% convenience fee will be avoided.



Cancellation Policy: The Trailside Lodge will accept cancellations up to 48 hours prior to check in time (3pm) on the date of the reservation. If cancellations are made within 48 hours of arrival date, you will be responsible for the cost of the reservation.

The lodge has ample parking for our trailer rigs. The Lodge does not have a continental breakfast, but dining options are close by. The ride details will be determined in the future.

A Michigan ORV license (\$26.25) is required on eligible county roads, state forest roads in the Upper Peninsula and eligible national forest roads. This license is required to operate anywhere off of private lands. In addition to the ORV license, an ORV trail permit (an additional \$10, for a total of \$36.25) is required when operating on designated and signed ORV trails and routes. The ORV license and the ORV trail permit are both valid for one year, which begins April 1 and ends March 31 of the following year. ORV licenses and trail permits can be purchased online through (<https://www.mdnr-elicence.com>) (your sticker will be mailed to you within 10 to 15 days). Some gas stations (Krist) and some powersport dealers near the Wisconsin/Michigan border may have them also.



A pre-ride is planned for this event June 2-4. Please contact Brad Dorn regarding questions about either of these events.

TRAILS

Very soon, as the snow disappears and the trails dry out, we will be out inspecting our trail system to evaluate the work required to ready the trails for an official trail opening. There may be several trees that winter knocked down, blocking the trails that needs to be attacked with chain saws and muscle.



There may be washouts from the spring thaw that need to be repaired. Critical traffic and safety signs may need replacing or reinstalled by driving posts into the ground. It is possible that many other issues could arise that need to be resolved before the trails can safely be opened for riding. This is the time for the need of many helping hands. 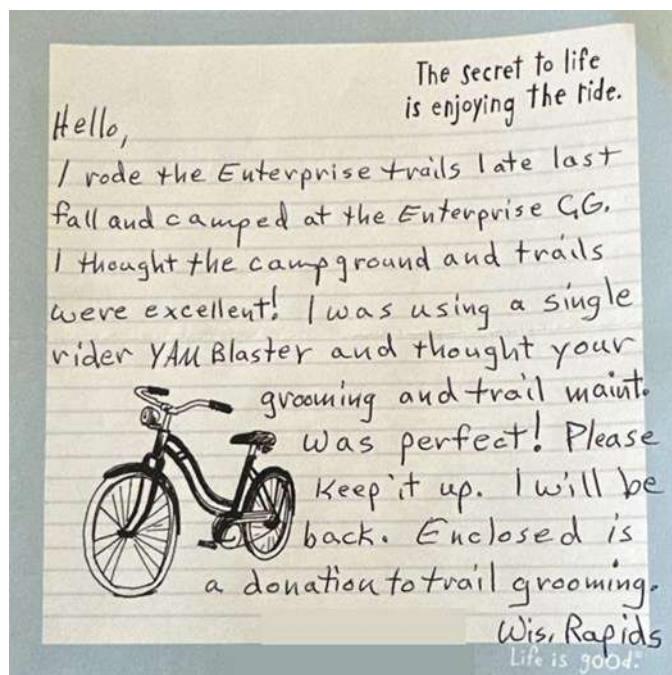

We were very pleased to find in our mailbox this note from an individual from Wisconsin Rapids. The note was accompanied with a significant donation to our club.

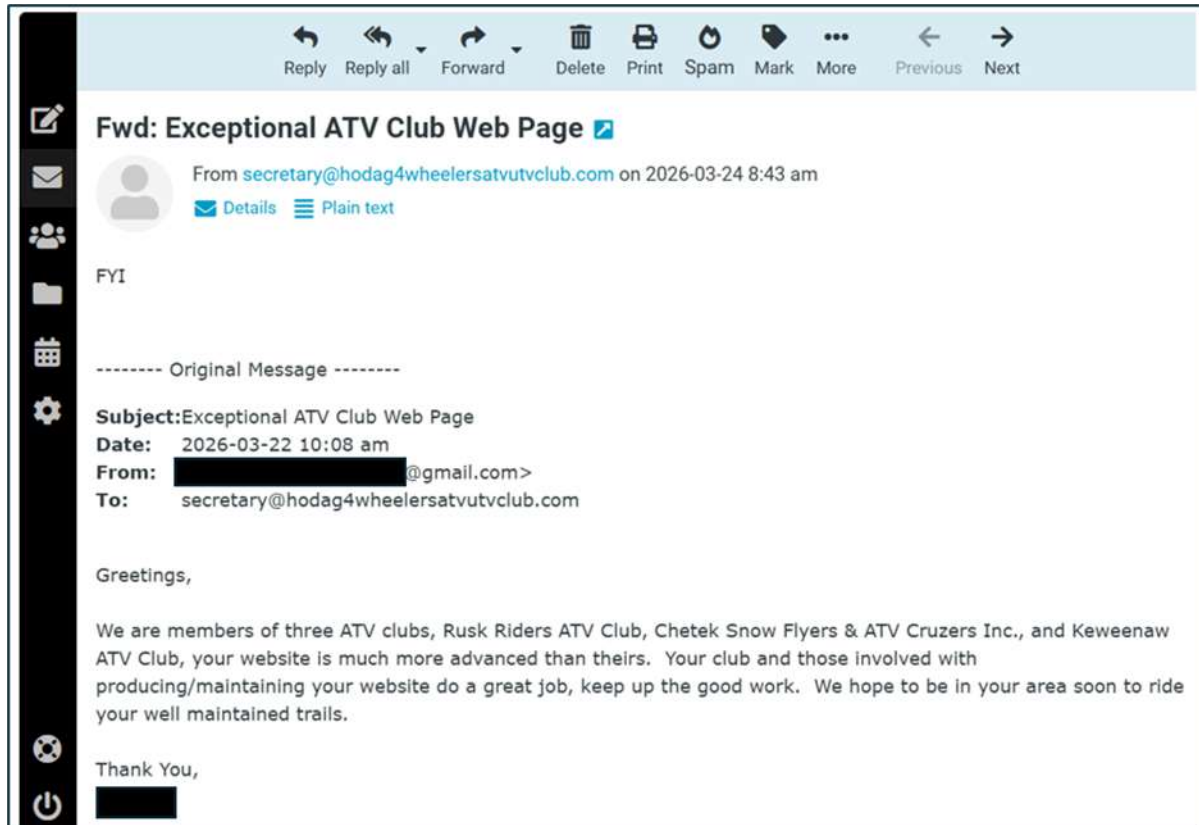
In addition to his generosity, we appreciate his time taken to sit down and write the kind words. He uses nifty stationery – note the messages on top right and lower right.

This is the 2nd year for the expo, held at the Sunnyview Expo Center in Oshkosh on May 1st and May 2nd. Last year, (23) ATV Clubs from around the state participated in the event, greeting the public to promote their clubs and about riding opportunities in their hometown area.

This year on Friday, May 1, there will be the following workshops for clubs to participate in and learn some helpful tools and strategies. The workshops are open for everyone who may be interested and they are free.

- 12:00 – 12:45: Reframing Alcohol Messaging
- 1:00 – 1:45: Membership Management Tool & Mapping
- 2:00 – 2:45: New Laws & Rule Changes
- 2:00 – 2:45: ATV/UTV Funding Challenges & Solutions
- 3:00 – 3:45: Trail Ambassador Program
- 3:00 – 3:45: DNR Safety Instructor Overview
- 4:00 – 4:45: Stop the Bleed (connects the national STOP THE BLEED® program with off-road safety, teaching riders how to control life-threatening bleeding after crashes or trail accidents).

This is a slate of some very good workshops that would be useful for our club. If they interest you to learn on behalf of your club, please volunteer to attend. Contact an officer of the club to let us know.

The expo hall will be open on Friday until 9:00 PM for clubs to organize their booths. This can also be done from 7:00 to 9:00 AM on May 2nd. At 9:00 AM, the expo opens to the public and continues until 6:00 PM. Immediately following the show closing, clubs can begin their booth teardown and return home.

This year, our booth will be adjacent to our neighboring clubs, the Pelcho Mudd Nutz ATV Club, the Parrish Highlanders ATV-UTV Club, and Harrison Hills ATV Club. We will collaborate together to market the 100-mile plus trails system that adjoins our club trails. Our mission is to educate the attendees about our great area that we have for riding and encourage them to give us a visit and support the area businesses. If we can get them to join our club or purchase a map, that will be a bonus.

Another Ride Possibility - Trek the Mighty Mac

September 25-26, 2026, Trek the Mighty Mac will once again feature the unforgettable Mackinac Bridge Crossing—along with all the activities riders know and love. Off-road enthusiasts are invited to join the 12th Annual Trek the Mighty Mac, open to SXS, 3-wheelers, 4-wheelers, and dirt bikes only. Each year, Trekkers gather in St. Ignace to enjoy food and gear vendors, a one-of-a-kind Saturday parade across the Mackinac Bridge, and an afternoon of off-roading adventures. You are invited to be part of the tradition!



Registration fee is \$30 per driver and \$25 per adult passenger (children 10 and under are free). Your registration includes bridge fare, staging, bus transportation, drink voucher, meet-n-greet activities and a Trek the Mighty Mac decal. There will be food trucks, or you can visit a St. Ignace restaurant for lunch. You will stage your machine at a designated location in Mackinaw City and cross the bridge to your St. Ignace motel or campground (we're hoping you stay in St. Ignace!). On Saturday morning we will pick you up by bus and transport you to the staging area. You will then ride your machine over the Mackinac Bridge and ride to the Little Bear Arena. After the ride, you can grab lunch or hit the trails.

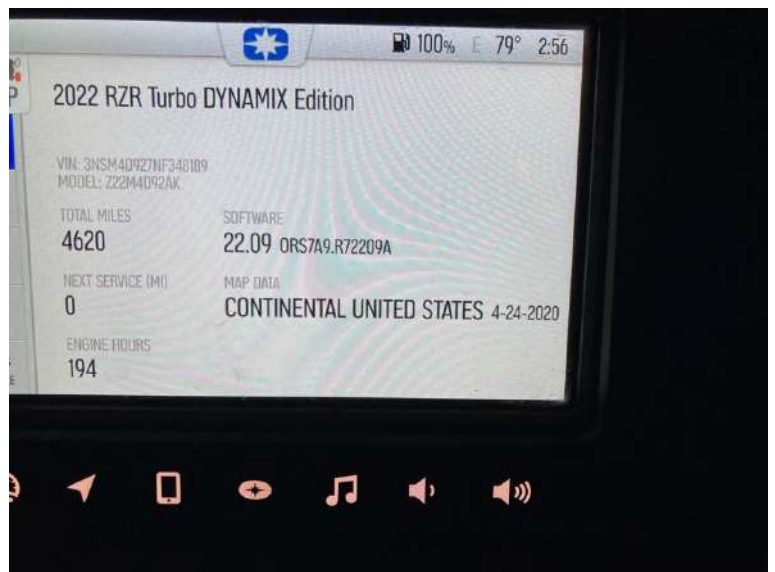
